



# Static and Dynamic IP Address Setup Information (Vista)


1. Click on Start button, then 'Control Panel' to get this Control Panel Window. Click on 'Network and Internet' to continue.




2. Network and Internet' window. Now click on 'Network and Sharing Center' to bring up the next window.




3. Examine the 'Network and Sharing Center' window. If there is a connection problem, there will be a red X over the line. Other icons may appear indicating other problems. The connections are also listed. In this case a working wireless and a working wired connection are listed. Click on 'Manage network connections' in the left menu.




- Right click on the icon of the appropriate connection. In this case, the wired connection is to be setup. When you right click a small pop-up window will appear. Click on the last item in the list, 'Properties.'




5. Once the Properties Window appears, highlight the 'TCP/IPv4' item by clicking on it.




6. Now click on the 'Properties Button.'



7. To setup a standard (dynamic) connection, leave everything defaulted to obtain addresses automatically.



8. For Static IP addresses, enter the numbers shown in the window below:



9. After entering the numbers, click 'OK' to back out of each window and to save the configuration.
